It started its operations with effect from Academic Session 2013-14 on its own 26 acre campus located at State Highway-22, Bahadurgarh-Jhajjar Road, Dist - Jhajjar.

#### TRAINING & PLACEMENT

Bahadurgarh, Jagan Nath University, separate Training & Placement Cell which constantly works to invite companies from various sectors to explore placement opportunities for the deserving students. The cell provides training to the students to foster professional values and work ethics along with grooming their personality and communication skills. The Industrial Projects taken by the students as the integral part of the study during Internships help the students to practice class learning in real situation. As a fact, many of the students get employment in the same organizations. The department holds Industrial Visits which provide the ideal opportunity for the students to understand the real functioning of the industry and get exposed to different work cultures. Training and Placement Cell also



supports feasibility in collaborations and bilateral tie-ups with different Universities for various courses at UG and PG levels and strives to provide a platform to the students to study culture consciousness.

The cell keeps the record of all the students of the university in an open access system (wherever required) in order to provide them better career opportunities. We also invite companies from various sectors to run a placement drive for all our eligible students. For this purpose Job fairs are organized from time to time. The T&P Cell remains involved actively during the entire selection process on individual basis. The entire mechanism of provision of training and placement for all our students is governed by meeting the norms of industry and local, state and central governments guidelines.

Training and development initiatives are educational activities within an organization that are designed to improve job performance The activities involve advancing students' knowledge and skill sets and instilling greater motivation.

Our Training and Placement Cell has conducts campus drives and online interviews. The qualified students are placed in the company with a salary up to 5 LPA. #### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MoU will offer a golden opportunity to the students of Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh, and hence they will be benefitted from different programmes offered by Impartus Innovations Private Limited.
- 2. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 between ISDC Projects India Private Limited and Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh, regarding exploration and providing facilities in various sectors. The objectives of this MoU is to provide Overseas Higher Studies Options for Jagannath University Graduates. ISDC Projects India Private Limited will provide articulation arrangement/credit exchange to Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh, students. Semester Exchange Program is one of the highlights of this MoU. ISDC will also provide Faculty Development Programs for the upliftment of the faculty of Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh. Other highlights of this MoU are having Joint Research Collaborations, providing Short Term Master Classes and providing International Conferences and Seminars/Events.
- 3. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2023 between International College of Financial Planning Limited under the brand name 'International College of Fashion' and Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh, regarding B.Voc. degree Program in Fashion Design & Technology. The major component of skilling is envisaged by the recently introduced National Education Policy, commonly referred to as NEP 2020. The highlight of this MoU is to conduct B.Voc. degree program in Fashion Design & Technology and other skill-based courses of shorter duration at different centers as per agreed terms.



#### INFRASTRUCTURE

The detail of various infrastructure facilities available is highlighted as under:

#### A. CLASS ROOMS

Teaching is not just loading the students with lectures and lessons. It is more about promoting their comprehensive skills through different pedagogical methods and tools. Classroom learning at JNUB provides the most conducive environment for dynamic and focused discussions. It has been deliberately designed to bring together analysis with action and is augmented by well-equipped facilities. Each classroom is air-conditioned as well as Wi-Fi enabled which provides a continuous access to internet for better comprehension. The classrooms are equipped with multimedia and audio-visual aids to facilitate effective learning and thereby promoting maximum interaction between faculty and students.

Classroom learning is intense and interactive, where students learn the latest technologies, tools and knowledge to face the dynamic changing - world realities. The concepts taught in classes form the basis, while actual learning occurs through constant interaction between faculty and students and practical exposure. The teaching learning process is carried out through the use of LCD projectors. This helps the students in understanding real world corporate situations and prepares them for the battle that lies ahead. The University has four teaching blocks to provide sufficient space for classrooms for the existing courses.

#### **B.** LABORATORIES

The University has well equipped separate labs for each program for teaching and research. The labs take care of the instruction on fundamentals to all students. Students use resources of laboratories to solve problems, perform developmental experiments and work on projects guided by faculty. By granting longer hours lab facility and access to the network in each classroom and lecture theatre, information is easily accessible from any point within the campus. The experiments are designed to provide deeper understanding of phenomenon, facts and fabrication/assembling of equipment from components to get hands-on experience. The drudgery of repetitive measurements is reduced by shift forwards microcomputer-based laboratory which allows the detailed analysis and interpretation of acquired data for our students.



#### C. CONFERENCE ROOM

The state-of- the-art Conference Room of the University is spacious, well-furnished and well-equipped with all the information and communication tools and interfaces for facilitating multimedia presentations by the students, the faculty and the visiting scholars. This hi-tech facility is alternatively used from time to time for mock group discussions, personal interviews and quiz sessions, debates, declamations and for many other activities meant for equipping the students with soft skills and corporate attitudes.

#### D. LIBRARY

The University library has fast emerged as an epicentre of knowledge, information, research material and all other technical logistics absolutely needed for moving in gear with global knowledge scenario. We have a spacious library which is automated and well stocked with the latest text books, reference material, national and international journals and periodicals, dissertations and thesis. The latest reference and research material is available both in print and digital formats. We have a number of presentation files, discussion papers, government publications, reports and newsletters, project reports, CDs, e-journals, back volumes as a support for management, information technology, economics etc. The library has 'Book Bank' facility to give textbook support to students. We have around 18700 books in our library at present. We also have online database i.e. Delnet Membership, which provides online access of selected E-books, E-Journals (National and International), Articles and Supreme Court Cases online Database. We have an access to Supreme Court Cases (SCC) for the students of Department of Law. The platform of National Digital Library at the university has been built by the MHRD in collaboration with IIT Kharakpur.

#### E. UNIVERSITY COMPUTER CENTRE (UCC)

In order to empower different courses being taught in the University, UCC has created a fairly rich e-infrastructure. UCC is fully equipped to help and empower all other academic modules. Our IT resources are future savvy and adaptable for future changes. The UCC has high speed Intel i5 12<sup>th</sup> Generation 4.40 GHz windows 2011, server 2022 based networking system. UCC is enriched with Scanners, LCDs, Laser Printers, Combo Drivers and Web Cam for video Conferencing and other purposes. The Centre caters to the needs of the students and faculty under one roof.



#### F. HOSTELS

This University renders services not only to the learning needs of the day scholars of Haryana State and Delhi-NCR but also to the scholars coming from far flung areas. The University at present has separate hostels for Boys and Girls. The hostel rooms are spacious, well furnished, comfortable and with proper learning environment. The hostels have 24 hours Wi-Fi internet facility, indoor sports facilities and gym. The hostels are equipped with generators to provide 24 hour electricity. Round the clock security in terms of CCTV, male and guards, separate for both the hostels is enforced for constant vigilance and surveillance. The hostel mess is run under the care and guidance of the respective Hostel Wardens.

#### G. SPORTS

To provide a break to the students from busy schedule of academics, the students are encouraged to play games and participate in physical exercises. This also promotes companionship and comradeship among the students. Facilities and grounds have been provided for Cricket, Football, Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton and Athletics. Facilities for indoor games like Chess, Carrom Board and Table-Tennis is available at the University. To encourage competition and sportsman spirit, sports competitions are regularly held. Outstanding sportsmen are encouraged to participate in matches and competitions are held by other institutions including the competitions organized by AIU.

#### H. CAFETERIA

The University has a well-furnished and spacious canteen. It is managed by experienced staff. The staff and space is checked for hygiene and cleanliness periodically by the Committee headed by the Registrar. Students are provided with snacks and meals at very competitive rates. These rates are fixed by the Committee periodically. The dining area is provided with aesthetic furniture and other facilities.

#### I. TRANSPORT FACILITY

Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh, has arranged excellent transport facility to save students' precious time and hassle-free commutation. The University has its own fleet of buses which provides connectivity with all the rural and urban areas of Delhi, Gurgaon, Rohtak, Bahadurgarh, etc., to ensure timely and comfortable journey to and from Campus. These buses undergo periodic maintenance to ensure reliable and comfortable operations. Students have the convenience of boarding the University buses from the designated pick-up points, this facility is meticulously being managed by the University Staff. The students are charged reasonable fee to avail the bus facility.

#### J. FIRST-AID

University-level first aid services play a crucial role in ensuring the well-being of students, faculty and staff within academic institutions. These services go beyond basic medical assistance, offering a comprehensive approach to emergency response and health support.

First-aid teams at Jagannath University comprises of trained professionals and volunteers equipped to handle a range of medical situations. They provide immediate assistance during accidents, illnesses, or any health-related emergencies on campus. This includes administering basic medical care assessing injuries, and facilitating the prompt transfer of individuals to healthcare centers when necessary.

Moreover, university first-aid services contribute to creating a safer and more secure campus environment.



#### **UNIVERSITY ACTIVITIES SESSION 2022-23**

#### i. SC/ST/OBC Cell

The University has a separate SC/ST/OBC Cell to help students coming from SC/ST/OBC background to provide guidance, counselling and help in educational matters like admissions in courses in the areas of their competence, the management aspects of education while in the institution and drawing benefits of various schemes of the State and the Central Governments specific to the SC/ST/OBC students.

The Cell guides and helps students for easy and effective processing of scholarship proposals for SC/ST/OBC students. The seminar was very informative for all the participants as it was a brainstorming session about the teachings and sermons of Guru Nanak Dev towards world peace.








#### 2. NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY-2022 CELEBRATION

Further there was a Mounting Room, Filling Room and Packaging Room, where bottles were being made and then they were taken to packaging areas where the filling, capping, labelling and packaging of bottles and storage was happening which were stored at the Preserving or Cold Storage Area.

This tour was highly informative for all students in context to their Industrial Exposure and for awareness on healthy living sources.








#### 3. GUEST LECTURE ON PHARMA INDUSTRY & WHERE I FIT IN

The pain was so severe that I was unable to raise my hands and perform the activities of daily life. I visited Medanta Hospital, Gurugram, The doctors there advised me surgery of shoulder joint. Then I visited Physiotherapy Department of Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh, Before coming here, I had pain and was unable to move my shoulder. After continuous treatment for one month my pain vanished completely and the range improved in no time. After that, the treatment was for alternate days for couple of weeks. After entire treatment there was no pain and full range of motion in shoulder. Now I am pain free and on home exercise regimen. I thank and appreciate the treatment that Jagannath University provided me".



"I Madhumati, 46 years old Female, resident of village Kherka fell and fractured my hand. My hand was plastered for a month following the injury. After the plaster was removed my hand was highly inflamed and stiff, as a result of cast there was no movement in the joint. I visited a local healthcare provider of the neighbourhood, but the condition didn't improve. Then, I visited Physiotherapy Department of Jagannath University, Bahadurgarh. After the treatment of 15 days my inflammation reduced and the range of motion of joint improved."

#### 1. VISIT TO KISAN MELA

Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar, organised a Kisan Mela on September 13, 2022. There was a large congregation of farmers and other stakeholders from across the entire country. One of the unique features of this mela was that there were more than 300 live demonstrations of different crops; intensive interactions between farmers and scientists in regional languages; etc. Professor B.R. Kamboj, Vice-chancellor, CCSHAU, Hisar, inaugurated the Kisan Mela, whose theme was "Water Conservation". He appreciated the efforts of agricultural scientists and called upon farmers to produce more cereals, pulses, oilseeds, and horticultural crops using modern techniques to meet the growing demand.

The V<sup>th</sup> semester students of the Department of Agriculture, accompanied by Dr. Amit and Dr. Sagar, visited this Kisan Mela. Various technologies developed by CCSHAU were displayed in the thematic pandal, where some progressive farmers also shared their experiences with the latest technologies with the students. The students saw different varieties of pulses like kidney beans, chicken peas, etc. and cereals like maize, wheat, rice, etc. Nutritionally-improved varieties of vegetables like capsicum, cauliflower, broccoli, tomato, etc and fruits like the mango, bael, melons, and banana were also displayed. The students also got a chance to interact with Dr. Kuldeep (Maize Breeder), who shared his experience. He also explained the different varieties and species of maize and how and when to use pesticides and herbicides in this crop.







#### 2. TRAINING PROGRAMME ON MAKHANA CULTIVATION

The students of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture 5<sup>th</sup> semester opted for the training of "Makhana Production" organized by "Jhajjar Power Limited" at Samvad Bhavan Jhajjar, Haryana. The main objective of this training was to impart knowledge on Makhana (Fox Nut) cultivation to students.

During the valedictory session, the participants were asked to express their views regarding the training pertaining to fox nut. In an open environment, the participants expressed their views regarding the training, its duration, contents, faculty members and their suggestions for future improvement. This training was immensely beneficial to the participants as it provided insight and practical aspects of Makhana Cultivation besides the theoretical knowledge. The participants were satisfied with the assistance/facilities provided by the staff/officials during their 5 days training.

#### 3. WORLD SOIL DAY

The event started with an introductory talk by Dr. R.S. Malik (Dean) on 'Soil Health', who gave a briefing about of the event. He discussed about the importance of soil among various living beings, biodiversity, deforestation and how humans are involved in degrading soil quality. He also emphasized on the improper disposal of medical waste and its impact on the soil. Finally, as a solution, he suggested using the contouring methods of cultivation and ensuring that the soil should be covered with green materials.

A quiz competition was organized among the students of the Department of Agriculture in which seven teams participated. Questions related to soil health were asked by the faculty and as per rules the teams were evaluated and the winners of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and3<sup>rd</sup> position were awarded with suitable prizes.

The students of agriculture science also participated in slogan writing on World Soil Day on Soil Health topics. Nearly 14 students participated in this activity. The evaluation was done by the judging committee and the best three posters were awarded accordingly.

In the concluding session, Dr. R.S Malik addressed the students and talked about activities organized and encouraged the students for their participation. Dr. R. S. Malik and faculty members distributed prizes to the students. We would like to thank Registrar Madam for her continuous support and motivation for such activities. The programme ended with a vote of thanks.





#### 4. Visit to Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Rohtak




#### 3. ONE DAY WEBINAR ON MODERN MARKETING TECHNIQUES


#### 1. ONE DAY NATIONAL WEBINAR "ENHANCING
