I have been directed to inform you that the State government has granted NOC for the following new courses proposed to be started by your University as per the details given below:-


1. Engineering and Technology
M. Tech. (Part Time) – 03 years
2. Ph.D (Physiotherapy) -02 to 5 years
3. B.Sc (Agriculture) – 04 years
4. Diploma in Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences – 01 year
5. M.Sc in Yoga and Management- 02 year
6. Bachelor of Naturopathy and Yogic Sciences (BNYS) –

The approval shall be subject to the following conditions:-

1. The eligibility criterion for admission to undergraduate and post graduate programmes, number of seats in each programme/course and the duration of courses should be in line with the norms and regulations of UGC/ MCI/INC/ AICTE/Arch. etc and other regulatory authorities.
2. The faculty to be engaged should be well qualified, and as per UGC norms and regulations.
3. Choice Based Credit System shall be mandatory and communication skills, information technology skills and basic mathematics must be included in the curriculum for all students. The core subjects and the elective subjects should be well defined before starting the new course
4. The aforementioned amendments shall be incorporated and the necessary changes may also be made so as to make the new programmes more effective and viable
5. The number of faculty members to be engaged shall also be in accordance with the UGC guidelines/ norms and these details must be prominently displayed on the website of the University.
6. The subject of Environmental studies will be mandatory at all the under graduate levels in compliance to the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court Of India

It was further directed that it will be mandatory for the university to upload the following information's on the website of the University:

- (a) Number of courses being run at the university with the details of the letter issued by the department w.r.t the NOC granted and other permissions granted by a regulatory authority.
- (b) Name, qualification, aadhar number and designation of each faculty member
- (c) Information about the mode of admissions (based on Marks or Entrance examination in case of technical and professional courses only as per the provisions under the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006)
- (d) Number of admitted students in each course along with the details about students of Haryana domicile, scholarship granted, fee concession given, etc. as per the provisions made under the Haryana Private University Act, 2006
- (e) The Aadhar number of every student.
- (f) Aadhar seeded Bank account number of students where scholarship of any kind is provided.


