Subject: Conduct of Examination for the Session 2019-20

1. It is for the information of all concerned that the End-Term Examinations (Theory/Practical) of all terminal classes (final semester/year) will be conducted w.e.f. July 13, 2020. The mode of Examination will be online through Google Meet and Google Class/ Mail Id.
2. The end-term examination for all the following terminal classes are going to be conducted in July 2020:

 - ix. BALLB – 10th Sem.
 - x. BPT – 4th year
 - xi. MPT – 2nd year
 - xii. MBA – 4th Sem.
 - xiii. BBA – 6th Sem.3.
 - xiv. B .Com. – 6th Sem.
 - xv. B.Arch – 10th Sem.
 - xvi. BAJMC – 6th Sem.
 - xvii. Diploma in Agriculture – 2nd Semester

NOTE:

- i. The date sheets are available on the University website www.jagannathuniversityncr.ac.in.
 - ii. The roll numbers will be issued to the students by the respective HoDs. The students are directed to clear all the pending dues before issue of roll no. slip latest by July 09, 2020.
 - iii. The link for appearing in examination will be sent only to those students who will be having valid roll. no. slip.
 - iv. Each theory paper will be of two hours duration and will carry 50 marks. Detailed instructions about the structure of question paper and internal assessment evaluation are being issued separately.
 - v. Important instructions for students for appearing in Online Examination are being issued separately by the Examination Branch.
3. Any student not able to appear in online examination may be considered on written request for promotion with 50% weightage of marks in internal assessment /assignments plus 50% weightage of marks of previous examinations. However, the student exercising this option will have to submit application in writing to HoD after clearing all pending dues, failing which he/she will be considered as absent from examination.

As per the instruction of Higher Education and Technical Education Departments, Govt. of Haryana, dated June 23, 2020, such students will have the option for examination for improvement of grades later on by physical examination basis once the normally prevails in the State.

4. For intermediate semester/year examinations, the students will be promoted provisionally to the next semester/class. They will appear in end term examination during the next semester/year when Corona Pandemic situation becomes normal, and/or the final decision with regard to their promotion to next semester and also previous re-appear examinations will be taken during the semester keeping in view the instructions of the regulatory authorities in this regard. However, all such students are required to clear their pending fee dues by July 15, 2020 and deposit the next semester fee by July 31, 2020. The regular classes for the next semester/year will commence from August 03, 2020.
5. All the students of the various Departments are directed to get in touch with their respective HoDs immediately for further instructions regarding promotion to next semester, deposit of fee and conduct of classes.
